





This wonderful 7 bedroom, 3 storey grade II listed Georgian gem is discreetly located, set back from the road approached via a 130' driveway

The spacious accommodation still retains many period features including, panelling, ceiling moulds, fireplaces, intricate door surrounds and furniture. Extending to over 5,800 sq. ft, the house sits on a plot of 0.32 acre. The main house was built in 1745 with later additions c 1850, 1900 and 1990 was the former home of the Labour Prime Minister Ramsey MacDonald (1925-1937) as well as the American scriptwriter and refugee from McCarthyism, Donald Ogden Stewart (1953-1980) with notable visitors including Charlie Chaplin, Katherine Hepburn, Ingrid Berman and W.E.B Dubois. The house is complemented by an exceptional 190' SouthWest facing garden and off street parking for 5 to 6 cars.


